You will be fed, given refreshments, your horses will be provided with a clean and safe environment while attending our events. In exchange for this we ask the following:

**RIDER REQUIREMENTS:**

1. All riders must be able to ride training level and above to participate in any clinic hosted by Team EnGaged. \*
2. Dress and turnout: all riders will wear appropriate clinic attire. This means: clean breeches, clean tall boots or leggings, helmet, gloves and polo. Horses must also be in appropriate clinic attire. Clean tack, white or black square pad (farm/sponsor logos are allowed) and polos/boots. Braiding is optional.
3. Be on time for your ride. If you are late, we will not add more time or rearrange schedules.
4. When warming up for your ride, please keep to the far end of the arena until the clinician is ready for you.
5. Cell phones off, silenced or on vibrate. Cell phones will not be allowed in the arena, or in the auditing areas.
6. No dogs.
7. No smoking.
8. Mind your manners. We host clinics and classes in positive, friendly environments. We expect our participants to be kind, courteous, civil and professional to each other. If you cannot do this, we will ask you to leave, without refund and without return invitation.

\*However, clinicians and instructors may have different requirements on a clinic by clinic basis. On those occasions we will ask anyone who wishes to participate to submit their scores and/or video of them riding.

### **AUDITOR REQUIREMENTS:**

1. Reservations are required. There will be an additional fee, for entry at the door, at time of clinic unless prepaid.
2. You must remain seated while clinic is in session. Please be prepared to sit for three to four hours. We ask this to minimize distraction to our riders and teachers.
3. Do not approach the clinician.
4. The stabling area is strictly off limits.
5. If you have questions, please leave them to the end of the session.
6. Dress: casual with collared shirt and close toed shoes.
7. Food: help us keep the area neat. Do not bring food into the riding and auditing areas.
8. Chair space is limited, please bring your own chair.
9. No photos or video for personal use.
10. Cell phones off, silenced or on vibrate. Cell phones will not be allowed in the arena, or in the auditing areas.
11. No dogs.
12. No smoking.
13. Mind your manners. We host clinics and classes in positive, friendly environments. We expect our participants to be kind, courteous, civil and professional to each other. If you cannot do this, we will ask you to leave, without refund and without return invitation.
